Osprey Care (Penticton) Inc. is pleased to advise that “The Hamlets at Penticton”, a Residential Care and Assisted Living facility which was partially destroyed by fire on the evening of April 6, 2008 is continuing to undergo reconstruction. In cooperation with the IHA and City of Penticton officials, the management at the Hamlets at Penticton is eagerly anticipating opening 32 Residential Care beds on July 7th – the first phase of a several-stage opening now planned as a result of the fire.

We also look forward to welcoming the first round of new staff, who will join us for orientation the week of June 23rd.

Although subject to change, rough projections of the next phases to open are as follows:

- Phase 2, consisting of 32 additional Residential Care beds, Administrative and Recreation space is anticipated for August 2008,
- Phase 3, consisting of the final 32 Residential Care beds is projected to be this October/November,
- Phase 4, Assisted living, is expected to be complete at the end of 2008.

We once again wish to thank the citizens of Penticton for their support, encouragement and interest in “The Hamlets at Penticton”.
